## FORMER LIBERTY PATHOLOGIST SENTENCED FOR FAILING TO FILE TAX RETURNS

**KANSAS CITY, Mo.** – John F. Wood, United States Attorney for the Western District of Missouri, announced today that a former Liberty, Mo., pathologist has been sentenced in federal court for failing to file federal income tax returns.

**Miles J. Jones**, 56, of Liberty, was sentenced to 18 months in federal prison without parole on Thursday, Feb. 5, 2009. The court also ordered **Jones** to pay a fine of \$20,000. **Jones** must also pay \$79,225 in restitution to the Internal Revenue Service.

On Aug. 8, 2008, **Jones** pleaded guilty to two violations of failing to file federal tax returns for tax years 2002 and 2003. **Jones** was a medical doctor with his own practice, Consultative and Diagnostic Pathology, during those years.

**Jones** earned \$267,800 in 2002 and \$271,000 in 2003. The taxes due and owing on his unfiled 2002 returns was \$63,498 and the taxes due and owing on his 2003 returns was \$10,231.

This case was prosecuted by Assistant U.S. Attorney Roseann A. Ketchmark. It was investigated by IRS-Criminal Investigation.
