**INDICTMENT**

THE GRAND JURY CHARGES:

**COUNT 1**

From in or about June, 2011 through on or about May 18, 2012, in the Eastern District of Arkansas and elsewhere,

CHRISTOPHER ARNOLD HOGAN  
ZACHARY DYLAN CORDELL  
ERIC EUGENE HARLOW  
JEREMY SCOTT ALLEN  
ANGELIQUE RENEE HOGAN and  
KRISTIAN HOGAN

conspired with each other and others known and unknown to the grand jury to knowingly and intentionally possess with intent to distribute and to distribute Methylone, Pentedrone, 3, 4 Methylenedioxy methcathinone aka bk-MDMA, and Methylenedioxy pyrovalerone aka MDPV, which are Schedule I controlled substances and analogs of Schedule I controlled substances intended for human consumption, in violation of Title 21, United States Code,

Section 841(a)(1), (b)(1)(C) and 846.

COUNT 2

On or about February 28, 2012, in the Eastern District of Arkansas,

ZACHARY DYLAN CORDELL

knowingly and intentionally possessed with intent to distribute and distributed Pentedrone, an analog of a Schedule I controlled substance, knowing that the substance was intended for human consumption in violation of Title 21, United States Code, Section 813, all in violation of Title 21, United States Code, Section 841(a)(1) and (b)(1)(C).

COUNT 3

On or about February 28, 2012, in the Eastern District of Arkansas,

ERIC EUGENE HARLOW

knowingly and intentionally possessed with intent to distribute and distributed Pentedrone, an analog of a Schedule I controlled substance, knowing that the substance was intended for human consumption in violation of Title 21, United States Code, Section 813, all in violation of Title 21, United States Code, Section 841(a)(1) and (b)(1)(C).

COUNT 4

On or about March 17, 2012, in the Eastern District of Arkansas,

CHRISTOPHER ARNOLD HOGAN and JEREMY SCOTT ALLEN

knowingly and intentionally possessed with intent to distribute and distributed Pentedrone, an analog of a Schedule I controlled substance, knowing that the substance was intended for human consumption in violation of Title 21, United States Code, Section 813, all in

violation of Title 21, United States Code, Section 841(a)(1) and (b)(1)(C).

COUNT 5

On or about March 29, 2012, in the Eastern District of Arkansas,

CHRISTOPHER ARNOLD HOGAN and JEREMY SCOTT ALLEN

aiding and abetting one another, knowingly and intentionally possessed with intent to distribute and distributed Pentedrone, an analog of a Schedule I controlled substance, knowing that the substance was intended for human consumption in violation of Title 21, United States Code, Section 813, all in violation of Title 21, United States Code, Section 841(a)(1) and (b)(1)(C), and Title 18, United States Code, Section 2.

COUNT 6

On or about April 12, 2012, in the Eastern District of Arkansas,

ZACHARY DYLAN CORDELL

knowingly and intentionally possessed with intent to distribute and distributed Methylenedioxypropylvalerone aka MDPV, a Schedule I controlled substance, in violation of Title 21, United States Code, Section 841(a)(1) and (b)(1)(C).

COUNT 7

On or about April 17, 2012, in the Eastern District of Arkansas,

ANGELIQUE RENEE HOGAN

having knowledge of a crime that can be prosecuted in the United States District Court for the Eastern District of Arkansas, to wit: conspiracy to possess with intent to distribute a controlled substance and analogs of a controlled substance under Title 21, United States

Code, sections 841(a)(1) and 846 as charged in Count 1, did knowingly and intentionally conceal such criminal activity and fail to as soon as possible make known the same criminal activity to some judge or other person in civil or military authority under the United States, in violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 4.

COUNT 8

On or about May 18, 2012, in the Eastern District of Arkansas,

CHRISTOPHER ARNOLD HOGAN

knowingly and intentionally possessed with intent to distribute Pentedrone, an analog of a Schedule I controlled substance, knowing that the substance was intended for human consumption in violation of Title 21, United States Code, Section 813, all in violation of Title 21, United States Code, Section 841(a)(1) and (b)(1)(C).
