NEWS RELEASE SUMMARY - September 28, 2012

United States Attorney Laura E. Duffy announced the sentencing today of Richard Alan Wolf, an attorney, previously employed as a child support officer for San Diego County, based upon his conviction for receipt of child pornography, in violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 2252(a)(2). United States District Judge William Q. Hayes sentenced Wolf to serve 60 months in prison, followed by seven years of supervised release. Judge Hayes also ordered Wolf to register as a sex offender. Wolf pled guilty in March 2012.

According to court records, federal agents with the United States Postal Inspection Service learned that Wolf participated in international bulletin boards that exchanged child pornography. At the time of his arrest, according to court records, Wolf's computer contained more than 72,000 images and 185 video files of child pornography and erotica.

This case stems from an investigation by the United States Postal Inspection Service.

This case was brought as part of Project Safe Childhood, a nationwide initiative launched in May

2006 by the Department of Justice to combat the growing epidemic of child sexual exploitation and abuse.

Led by the United States Attorneys' Offices and the Criminal Division's Child Exploitation and Obscenity

Section, Project Safe Childhood marshals federal, state, and local resources to locate, apprehend, and

prosecute individuals who sexually exploit children, and to identify and rescue victims. For more
