IOWA CITY MAN SENTENCED FOR CHILD PORNOGRAPHY OFFENSES

DAVENPORT, IA – On December 1, 2011, Monte Jay Brummer, age 58, of Iowa City, IA, was sentenced to 72 months imprisonment in connection with receipt and distribution of child pornography, announced United States Attorney Nicholas A. Klinefeldt. United States District Judge Robert W. Pratt also sentenced Brummer to five years supervised release following imprisonment.

On August 31, 2009, officers executed a search warrant at Brummer's residence in Iowa City, seizing three computers containing a total of 46 videos and 529 images of child pornography. Brummer admitted using peer-to-peer file sharing programs to download child pornography and to distribute it to others.

The case was investigated by the Iowa Division of Criminal Investigation and was prosecuted by the United States Attorney's Office for the Southern District of Iowa.
