Altoona Man Sentenced to 57 Months

DES MOINES, IA – On March 4, 2011, Terry Lee Kiser, age 59, of Altoona, Iowa, was sentenced to 57 months of imprisonment for possession with intent to distribute methamphetamine, announced United States Attorney Nicholas A. Klinefeldt. The Honorable United States District Court Judge James E. Gritzner also ordered Kiser to serve 3 years of supervised release, and to pay a special assessment of \$100 payable to the Crime Victim Fund.

On November 23, 2010, Kiser pled guilty to possession with intent to distribute methamphetamine. During the execution of a search warrant at Kiser's residence on April 12, 2010, officers seized methamphetamine, marijuana and a handgun.

This case was prosecuted by the United States Attorney's office for the Southern District of Iowa, and was investigated by the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms and Explosives, the Iowa Division of Narcotics Enforcement and the Altoona Police Department.
