DES MOINES MAN SENTENCED ON PRODUCTION OF CHILD PORNOGRAPHY CHARGE

DES MOINES, IA - On November 21, 2011, Kent Eugene Oman, age 28, of Des Moines, Iowa, was sentenced to 180 months imprisonment for producing child pornography, announced United States Attorney Nicholas A. Klinefeldt. United States District Judge Robert W. Pratt also sentenced Oman to ten years of supervised release following imprisonment and to pay \$100.00 to the Crime Victims Fund. man pleaded guilty to the offense on July 26, 2011

As part of the plea proceeding, Oman admitted that between January 31, 2009, and November 7, 2010, he knowingly and intentionally used a hidden camera to produce videos of a minor male using the bathroom on 15 - 20 separate occasions. He further admitted that at least one of the videos he produced of this minor male using the bathroom captured images where the focal point of the video was on the genitalia of the minor male.

This investigation was conducted by the Metropolitan Police Force in London, England, and the Department of Homeland Security Investigations in Des Moines, Iowa. The case was prosecuted by the United States Attorney's Office from the Southern District of Iowa.
