**DAVENPORT WOMAN SENTENCED TO 75 MONTHS OF IMPRISONMENT FOR
POSSESSION OF CRACK COCAINE WITH INTENT TO DISTRIBUTE**

DAVENPORT, IA - Following her earlier guilty plea on June 26, 2009, Cheryl Jean Thomas, age 40, of Davenport, Iowa, was sentenced on April 22, 2010, to 75 months of imprisonment for one count of possession with intent to distribute at least 5 grams of crack cocaine, announced United States Attorney Nicholas A. Klinefeldt. United States District Judge John A. Jarvey also ordered Thomas to serve a term of 8 years of supervised release following her incarceration and pay \$100 to the Crime Victims Fund.

On February 18, 2009, Davenport Police officers executed a search warrant at Thomas' residence in Davenport. Police found 37 grams of crack cocaine and \$2,315 in cash in Thomas' bedroom. A digital scale with residue and numerous baggies with the corners cut off (indicative of drug packaging) were found in the kitchen. More crack cocaine was found in the garage.

This investigation was conducted by the Davenport Police Department and prosecuted by the United States Attorney's Office, Southern District of Iowa.
