## Davenport Man Sentenced After Federal Convictions for Distribution of Crack Cocaine

DAVENPORT, IA - On June 22, 2012, Alim Jalloh, also known as Abel March, age 26, from Davenport, Iowa was sentenced to 96 months' imprisonment by United States District Judge John A. Jarvey, having previously pleaded guilty to two counts of distribution of crack cocaine, announced United States Attorney Nicholas A. Klinefeldt. Jalloh was also ordered to serve three years of supervised release following imprisonment and pay \$100 towards the Crime Victims Fund.

On March 26 and March 30, 2011, law enforcement officers conducted two controlled purchases of crack cocaine at Jalloh's residence in Davenport. On April 6, 2011, officers performed a search of the residence and seized additional crack cocaine and \$10,000 in cash.

Jalloh admitted obtaining crack cocaine from at least two different sources. Investigation revealed that Jalloh was receiving ounce quantities of crack cocaine from two different sources.

This case was investigated by the Drug Enforcement Administration, the Iowa

Department of Public Safety, Division of Narcotics Enforcement, and the Davenport, Iowa,

Police Department. This case was prosecuted by the United States Attorney's Office for the

Southern District of Iowa.
