**BELVIDERE MAN SENTENCED TO 10 YEARS IN FEDERAL PRISON  
FOR POSSESSING CHILD PORNOGRAPHY**

Rockford — A Belvidere, Ill. man was sentenced today in federal court by U.S. District Judge Philip G. Reinhard for possessing child pornography that had crossed state lines. **Richard K. Yohn**, 50, was sentenced to 10 years in federal prison, a fine of \$5,000, and ordered to serve a term of 25 years of supervised following his release from prison. Yohn pleaded guilty to the charge on July 12, 2012, admitting that in April 2010 a computer he owned contained images of children engaged in sexually explicit conduct.

The sentencing was announced today by Gary S. Shapiro, Acting United States Attorney for the Northern District of Illinois; Jan Noble, Chief of the Belvidere Police Department; and Frank Benedetto, Special Agent-in-Charge of the Chicago Field Office, U.S. Secret Service, Department of Homeland Security.

The government was represented by Assistant U.S. Attorney Michael D. Love.
