FEDERAL GRAND JURY IN FORT WAYNE RETURNS INDICTMENT

Fort Wayne, IN—The United States Attorney's Office announced that a Grand Jury sitting in Fort Wayne, Indiana, returned the following Indictment on September 28, 2011:

Alfred Alcaraz, 32, of Tucson, Arizona, is charged in a single count Indictment with conspiracy to possess with intent to distribute a controlled substance from on or about December 2009, up to and including on or about December 6, 2010. This charge was filed as the result of an investigation by the Drug Enforcement Administration, Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms and Explosives, and the Pulaski County Sheriff's Department, Missouri. This case has been assigned to and will be prosecuted by Assistant United States Attorney Robert N. Trgovich.

The specific sentence in each case to be imposed upon conviction will be determined by the judge after a consideration of federal sentencing statutes and the Federal Sentencing Guidelines.

The United States Attorney's Office emphasized that an Indictment is merely an allegation and that all persons charged are presumed innocent until and unless proven guilty in court.
