WEEK IN REVIEW – FORT WAYNE

Fort Wayne, Indiana- The United States Attorney's Office announced the following activity:

PLEAS:

- Justin Dominguez, 29, of Fort Wayne, Indiana, pled guilty before Judge Theresa Springmann to the felony offense of use of a communication facility to facilitate commission of distributing cocaine. These charges were filed as the result of an investigation by the Federal Bureau of Investigation, the Indiana State Police, the Fort Wayne Police Department, the Allen County Police Department, the Allen County Drug Task Force and the New Haven Police Department. This case is being prosecuted by Assistant United States Attorneys Lesley Miller Lowery and Anthony Geller.
- Manuel Gonzalez Avila, 40, of Fort Wayne, Indiana, pled guilty before Magistrate Judge Roger Cosby to the felony offense of possession with the intent to distribute heroin. These charges were filed as the result of an investigation by the Drug Enforcement Administration. This case is being prosecuted by Assistant United States Attorney Anthony Geller.
- Charley Gonzalez IV, 22, of Fort Wayne, Indiana, pled guilty before Magistrate Judge Roger Cosby to the felony offense of possession of a firearm by an unlawful user of a controlled substance. These charges were filed as the result of an investigation by the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms, and Explosives and the Federal Bureau of Investigation. This case is being prosecuted by Assistant United States Attorney Lovita Morris King.

The specific sentence in each case to be imposed upon conviction will be determined by the judge after a consideration of federal sentencing statutes and the Federal Sentencing Guidelines.

DISPOSITION:

- Martrell Coleman, 26, of Fort Wayne, Indiana, was sentenced by Judge Theresa Springmann to 60 months imprisonment and 4 years of supervised release after pleading guilty to the felony offense of possession with the intent to distribute crack cocaine. This case was the result of an investigation by the Drug Enforcement Administration and the Fort Wayne Police Department. This case was prosecuted by Assistant United States Attorney Anthony Geller.
