The United States Attorney charges that:

## COUNT 1

(Possession of Child Pornography)

Beginning at a time unknown and continuing until on or about April 1, 2009, within the Eastern District of Louisiana and elsewhere, the defendant, **JACOB B. JOHANNESSEN**, **JR.**, did knowingly possess one or more matters, that is, computer hard drives, disks, and other electronic media, containing digital images, computer images, and digital video files, which contained visual depictions that had been mailed, shipped, and transported in interstate and foreign commerce, and which were produced using materials which have been mailed, shipped,

and transported in interstate and foreign commerce, by any means including by computer, the production of which involved the use of a minor engaged in sexually explicit conduct, as defined in Title 18, United States Code, Section 2256(2), and such visual depictions were of such conduct; all in violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 2252(a)(4)(B).

## FORFEITURE ALLEGATION

- 1. The allegations of this indictment are re-alleged as if fully set forth herein, for the purpose of alleging forfeiture, pursuant to Title 18, United States Code, Section 2253.
- 2. If convicted of the offense set forth above, the defendant, **JACOB B. JOHANNESSEN**, shall forfeit to the United States any and all materials and property used and intended to be used in the receipt and possession of visual depictions of minors engaged in sexually explicit conduct, and any and all property, real or personal, constituting or traceable to

gross profits or other proceeds obtained from the offense. Such property includes, but is not limited to, the following specific items found by federal agents on or about April 1, 2009:

- a. HP Pavilion Laptop Computer, Serial No. 2CE7010MBW; and
- b. San Disc 2GB Computer Memory Card.
