COUNT 1

Between on or about October 26, 2009 and on or about December 14, 2009, in the Eastern District of Louisiana, the defendant, RENO JEAN DARET IV, did willfully, and for purposes of commercial advantage and private financial gain, circumvent a technological measure that effectively controls access to a work protected under Title 17 of the United States Code, namely, a copyrighted

work; all in violation of Title 17, United States Code, Sections 1201(a)(1)(A) and 1204(a).
