
COUNT 1

On or about March 5, 2010, in Lafourche Parish, in the Eastern District of Louisiana, the defendant, **ALEX ROBERTO ORTIS, a/k/a Alex Roberto Ortiz, a/k/a Alex Roberto Orti, a/k/a Jose Cardona, a/k/a Jose Cordona, a/k/a Jose Adolfo Ordon Cardonza, a/k/a Jose Adolfo Ordonez-Cardona, a/k/a Jose Ordonez-Cardona**, an alien, was found in the United States after having been officially deported and removed therefrom to Honduras on or about March 7, 2005, at

or near Harlingen, Texas, and without the Attorney General of the United States or his designated successor, the Secretary of the Department of Homeland Security, as provided for in Title 6, United States Code, Sections 202(3), 202(4), and 557, having expressly consented to the defendant's reapplication for admission into the United States; all in violation of Title 8, United States Code, Section 1326(a).



On or about July 27, 2010, in Jefferson Parish, in the Eastern District of Louisiana, the defendant, **JORGE BELTRAN-MARTINEZ**, a/k/a Jorge Alfredo Beltran-Martinez, a/k/a Jorge Alfredo Beltran, a/k/a Jorge Alfred Beltran-Martinez, a/k/a Jorge Alfred Beltran, a/k/a

Jorge Alfredo Martinez, a/k/a Jorge A. Beltran, a/k/a Moises Perez, a/k/a Moises Perez-Torres, a/k/a Moses Perez Torres, a/k/a Moses P. Torres, a/k/a Roberto Martinez Soto, an alien, was found in the United States after having been officially deported and removed therefrom to El Salvador on or about August 29, 2008, at or near Houston, Texas, and without the Attorney General of the United States or his designated successor, the Secretary of the Department of Homeland Security, as provided for in Title 6, United States Code, Sections 202(3), 202(4), and 557, having expressly consented to the defendant's reapplication for admission into the United States; all in violation of Title 8, United States Code, Section 1326(a).

NOTICE OF SENTENCING ENHANCEMENT

Now comes the United States of America, by and through Jim Letten, the United States Attorney for the Eastern District of Louisiana, to give notice that on or about August 1, 1997, in the District Court of Seward County, Kansas, the defendant, **JORGE BELTRAN-MARTINEZ, a/k/a Jorge Alfredo Beltran-Martinez, a/k/a Jorge Alfredo Beltran, a/k/a Jorge Alfred Beltran-Martinez, a/k/a Jorge Alfred Beltran, a/k/a Jorge Alfredo Martinez, a/k/a Jorge A. Beltran, a/k/a Moises Perez, a/k/a Moises Perez-Torres, a/k/a Moses Perez Torres, a/k/a Moses P. Torres, a/k/a Roberto Martinez Soto**, was convicted of aggravated battery. Because of this aggravated felony conviction, if the defendant is convicted for a violation of Title 8, United States Code, Section 1326(a) the defendant's sentence will be subject to a maximum

sentence of imprisonment for not more than 20 years. Title 8, United States Code, Section 1326(b)(2).

COUNT 1

On or about April 12, 2010, in Jefferson Parish, in the Eastern District of Louisiana, the defendant, **MAX EDGARDO MEZA-MANZANARES, a/k/a Max Meza, a/k/a Jose Martinez, Max Edgardo Meza Manzanares**, an alien, was found in the United States after having been officially deported and removed therefrom to Honduras on or about May 26, 2009, at or near San Antonio, Texas, and without the Attorney General of the United States or his designated successor, the Secretary of the Department of Homeland Security, as provided for in Title 6, United States Code, Sections 202(3), 202(4), and 557, having expressly consented to the defendant's reapplication

for admission into the United States; all in violation of Title 8, United States Code, Section 1326(a).

NOTICE OF SENTENCING ENHANCEMENT

Now comes the United States of America, by and through Jim Letten, the United States Attorney for the Eastern District of Louisiana, to give notice that on or about March 25, 2009, in the County Court of Nassau County, New York, the defendant, **MAX EDGARDO MEZA-MANZANARES, a/k/a Max Meza, a/k/a Jose Martinez, Max Edgardo Meza Manzanares**, was convicted of assault in the second degree. Because of this felony conviction, if the defendant is convicted for a violation of Title 8, United States Code, Section 1326(a), the defendant's sentence

will be subject to a maximum sentence of imprisonment for not more than 10 years. Title 8, United States Code, Section 1326(b)(1).
