The Grand Jury Charges that:

**COUNT 1**

On or about December 13, 2000, in the Eastern District of Louisiana, the defendant, **ALLEN A. GUILBEAU, JR.**, willfully and knowingly made false statements in an application for a passport with intent to induce and secure for his own use the issuance of a passport under the authority of the United States, in that in such application, **ALLEN A. GUILBEAU, JR.**, stated that he was in fact Jamie Paul Guilbeau, date of birth July 23, 1973 and presented a

fraudulent Louisiana Driver's License (#6117844) issued in the name of Jamie Paul Guilbeau,  
which information he knew to be false,

All in violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 1542.
