On or about May 24, 2010, in Orleans Parish, in the Eastern District of Louisiana, the defendant, ARTURO LAMAS-MUNOZ, a/k/a Raoul Hernandez, a/k/a Raul Garcia, a/k/a Arturo-Munoz Lopez, a/k/a Arturo Munoec Lamas, a/k/a Francisco Garcia Casteo, a/k/a Artour Lamas, a/k/a Artuto Nunez Lopezlamas, an alien, was found in the United States after having been officially deported and removed therefrom to Mexico on or about July 25, 2005, at or

near Laredo, Texas, and without the Attorney General of the United States or his designated successor, the Secretary of the Department of Homeland Security, as provided for in Title 6, United States Code, Sections 202(3), 202(4), and 557, having expressly consented to the defendant's reapplication for admission into the United States; all in violation of Title 8, United States Code, Section 1326(a).

NOTICE OF SENTENCING ENHANCEMENT

Now comes the United States of America, by and through Jim Letten, the United States Attorney for the Eastern District of Louisiana, to give notice that on or about February 1, 1993, in the Superior Court of Cobb County, Georgia, the defendant, ARTURO LAMAS-MUNOZ, a/k/a Raoul Hernandez, a/k/a Raul Garcia, a/k/a Arturo-Munoz Lopez, a/k/a Arturo Munoec Lamas, a/k/a Francisco Garcia Casteo, a/k/a Artour Lamas, a/k/a Artuto Nunez Lopezlamas, was convicted of terroristic threats and acts. Because of this aggravated felony conviction, if the defendant is convicted for a violation of Title 8, United States Code, Section 1326(a) the

defendant's sentence will be subject to a maximum sentence of imprisonment for not more than 20 years. Title 8, United States Code, Section 1326(b)(2).
