

The Grand Jury charges that:

COUNT 1

On or about February 17, 2010, at or near Orleans Parish, Louisiana, in the Eastern District of Louisiana, the defendant, **LEONEL GONZALEZ-CASTILLO**, a/k/a Leonel Castillo, an alien, was found in the United States after having been officially removed therefrom to Mexico on or about June 23, 2009, at or near Del Rio, Texas, and without the Attorney General of the United States or his designated successor, the Secretary of the Department of Homeland Security, as provided for in Title 6, United States Code, Sections 202(3), 202(4), and 557, having expressly consented to the defendant's reapplication for admission into the United States; all in violation of Title 8, United States Code, Section 1326(a).

NOTICE OF SENTENCING ENHANCEMENT

Now comes the United States of America, by and through Jim Letten, the United States Attorney for the Eastern District of Louisiana, to give notice that on or about July 30, 2003, in the Four Hundred Third Judicial District Court of Travis County, Texas, the defendant, **LEONEL GONZALEZ-CASTILLO**, a/k/a Leonel Castillo, was convicted of possession of a controlled substance, cocaine. Because of this felony conviction, if the defendant is convicted for a violation of Title 8 U.S.C. Section 1326(a), the defendant's sentence will be subject to a maximum sentence of imprisonment for not more than 10 years. Title 8, United States Code, Section 1326(b)(1).
