The Grand Jury charges that:

COUNT 1

On or about July 6, 2011, in St. Tammany Parish, in the Eastern District of Louisiana, the defendant, MIGUEL ANGEL MEJIA-GABRIEL, a/k/a Miguel Mejia-Gabriel, an alien, was found in the United States after having been officially deported and removed therefrom to Mexico on or about November 21, 2005, at or near Hidalgo, Texas, and without the Attorney General of the United States or his designated successor, the Secretary of the Department of Homeland Security, as provided for in Title 6, United States Code, Sections 202(3), 202(4), and 557, having expressly consented to the defendant's reapplication for admission into the United States; all in violation of Title 8, United States Code, Section 1326(a).

NOTICE OF SENTENCING ENHANCEMENT

Now comes the United States of America, by and through Jim Letten, the United States Attorney for the Eastern District of Louisiana, to give notice that on or about May 22, 2002, in the Superior Court of Fulton County, Georgia, the defendant, MIGUEL ANGEL MEJIA-GABRIEL, a/k/a Miguel Mejia-Gabriel, was convicted of aggravated child molestation. Because of this aggravated felony conviction, if the defendant is convicted for a violation of Title 8, United States Code, Section 1326(a), the defendant's sentence will be subject to a maximum sentence of imprisonment for not more than 20 years. Title 8, United States Code, Section 1326(b)(2).
