The Grand Jury charges that:

COUNT 1 - RECEIPT OF CHILD PORNOGRAPHY

Beginning at a time unknown, but not later than August 14, 2012, and continuing until on or about September 25, 2012, within the Eastern District of Louisiana, and elsewhere, the defendant, **RONALD BREAUX**, did knowingly receive, and attempt to receive, visual depictions, that is, digital images and computer images, that had been mailed, shipped, and transported in interstate and foreign commerce, by any means, including by computer, the production of which involved the use of a minor engaging in sexually explicit conduct as defined in Title 18, United States Code, Section 2256(2), and such visual depictions were of such conduct.

All in violation of Title 18, United States Code, Sections 2252(a)(2) and 2252(b)(1).

**NOTICE OF FORFEITURE**

1. The allegations of Count 1 of this Indictment are realleged and incorporated by reference as though set forth fully herein for the purpose of alleging forfeiture to the United States of America pursuant to the provisions of Title 18, United States Code, Section 2253.

2. As a result of the offenses, alleged in Count 1, defendant, **RONALD BREAU**X, shall forfeit to the United States all property, real or personal, constituting or traceable to gross profits or other proceeds obtained from such offenses; and/or any property, real or personal, used or intended to be used to commit or to promote the commission of such offenses, in violation of Title 18, United States Code, Sections 2252(a)(2) and 2253, including but not limited to:

- a. One (1) Mybook essential external hard drive, with serial number WCACZ0968257;
- b. One (1) Western Digital hard drive, with serial number WCASJ0389104;
- c. One (1) Dell laptop computer, with service tag number FMWWV6a;
- d. One (1) Maxtor external hard drive, with serial number B42HNHYH;
- e. One (1) Maxtor model LXT-213A hard drive, with serial number 1C0500539;
- f. One (1) Verbatim hard drive model CLON500GB, with lot number CH9907; and
- g. One (1) Dell desktop computer, model DHM, with serial number 4VKB311.

3. If any of the property described above as being subject to forfeiture, as a result of


any act or omission of the defendant:

- a. cannot be located upon the exercise of due diligence;
- b. has been transferred or sold to, or deposited with, a third person;
- c. has been placed beyond the jurisdiction of the Court;
- d. has been substantially diminished in value; or
- e. has been commingled with other property which cannot be subdivided without difficulty;

it is the intent of the United States, pursuant to Title 18, United States Code, Section 2253(o) to seek forfeiture of any other property of said defendant up to the value of the above forfeitable property.

All in violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 2253.




