The Scheme

2. In or about May 2007, defendant ANTHONY LAM engaged in a scheme to give, offer and agree to give a corrupt payment of cash to West New York public officials in order to obtain a Certificate of Occupancy for 320 62nd Street.

3. It was a part of the scheme that, on or about May 17, 2007, during a meeting at the C.W.'s office in West New York, defendant ANTHONY LAM offered to pay money to West New York public officials in order to resolve issues concerning 320 62nd Street.

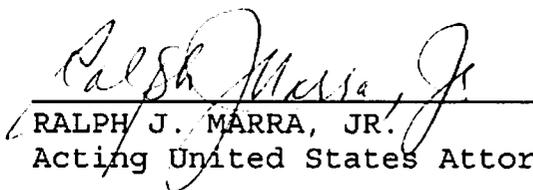
4. It was a further part of the scheme that, on or about May 30, 2007, at the C.W.'s office in West New York, defendant ANTHONY LAM gave the C.W. a cash payment of \$5,000 to be paid to West New York public officials for a Certificate of Occupancy for 320 62nd Street.

5. In or about May 2007, in Hudson County, in the District of New Jersey and elsewhere, defendant

ANTHONY LAM

did knowingly and corruptly give, offer, and agree to give a thing of value, namely a cash payment totaling \$5,000 to the C.W., with intent to influence and reward West New York public officials in connection with a business, transaction, and series of transactions of the Town of West New York involving a thing of value of \$5,000 and more.

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 666(a)(2) and Section 2.
