INFORMATION

The defendant having waived in open court prosecution by indictment, the United States Attorney for the District of New Jersey charges:

On or about December 9, 2008, in Camden County, in the District of New Jersey and elsewhere, defendant

RUSSELL B. MCLAUGHLIN, JR.,
did knowingly and corruptly give, offer, and agree to give a cash payment of approximately \$5,000 to Cherry Hill Township Director of the Department of Code Enforcement and Inspections Anthony Saccomanno, with the intent to influence and reward Saccomanno, in connection with a business, transaction, and series of transactions of the Township of Cherry Hill, involving a thing of value of \$5,000 or more, and involving a local government that received in excess of \$10,000 in federal funds assistance during the relevant one-year period.

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section
666(a)(2), and Title 18, United States Code, Section 2.
