INFORMATION

The defendant having waived in open court prosecution by indictment, the United States Attorney for the District of New Jersey charges:

1. From in or about July 2007, to in or about September 2008, in Camden County, in the District of New Jersey, and elsewhere, defendant

ANTHONY SACCOMANNO

did knowingly and willfully devise and intend to devise a scheme and artifice to defraud the Township of Cherry Hill and its citizens of the right to defendant SACCOMANNO's honest services in the affairs of the Township of Cherry Hill.

2. On or about November 27, 2007, for the purpose of executing and attempting to execute the scheme and artifice to defraud, defendant ANTHONY SACCOMANNO did knowingly and willfully cause a letter from the Cherry Hill Purchasing Administrator to Building Inspection Underwriters, Inc., to be sent, delivered, and moved by the United States Postal Service.

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Sections
1341 and 1346 and Section 2.
