The defendant having waived in open court prosecution by indictment, the United States Attorney for the District of New Jersey charges:

Between in or about March 17, 2010 and March 27, 2010, in Monmouth County, in the District of New Jersey and elsewhere, the defendant,

THANOMSAK HONGTHONG,
a/k/a "Tom,"

directly and indirectly, did knowingly and corruptly give, offer and promise a thing of value, namely \$100,000, to a public official, namely a contracting officer employed by the United States Department of Defense ("DoD") at Fort Monmouth, New Jersey, and acting for the DoD and on its behalf, with the intent to: (A) influence official acts; (B) influence the contracting officer to commit, aid in committing, collude in and allow, and make opportunity for the commission of, fraud on the United States; and (C) induce the contracting officer to do and omit to do acts in violation of his lawful duties.

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 201(b)(1) and Title 18, United States Code, Section 2.

CRIMINAL FORFEITURE ALLEGATION

1. The allegations contained in this Information are hereby realleged and incorporated by reference for the purpose of alleging forfeitures pursuant to Title 18, United States Code, Section 981(a)(1)(C) and Title 28, United States Code, Section 2461(c).

2. Upon conviction of the bribery offense, in violation of 18 U.S.C. §§ 201(b)(1), alleged in this Information, the defendant,

THANOMSAK HONGTHONG,
a/k/a "Tom,"

shall forfeit to the United States, pursuant to Title 18, United States Code, Section 981(a)(1)(C) and Title 28, United States Code, Section 2461(c), \$10,000 in United States currency, currently in the custody of the United States, which THANOMSAK HONGTHONG paid to a government official on March 27, 2010, and which constitutes or is derived from proceeds traceable to the commission of the bribery offense in violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 201(b)(1), alleged in this Information.

All pursuant to Title 18, United States Code, Section 981(a)(1)(C) and Title 28, United States Code, Section 2461(c).
