

ATTACHMENT A

I, Brian McCaffery, am a Special Agent with the Federal Bureau of Investigation. I have knowledge of the following facts based upon my investigation, review of reports and discussions with other law enforcement personnel and others. All statements herein are set forth in substance and in part:

1. Beginning in or around July 2009, a confidential informant ("the CI"), with a proven record of reliability and credibility, provided information that defendants GERRAL INGRAM, a/k/a "Rell," WILLIAM INZAR, a/k/a "Ill Will," JAHROD KEARNEY, a/k/a "Spazz," DANNY JOSEPH, KHAYRI McMILLAN, a/k/a "Kah," AHMOD BRUTON, a/k/a "Snap," and WADE BRUTON, a/k/a "Buggs" (collectively, "Defendants") belonged to or are associated with a criminal street gang known as the "Grape Street Crips."

CONSPIRACY

2. From in or around July 2009 through in or around November 2009, in Essex County, in the District of New Jersey, and elsewhere, Defendants conspired and agreed each other and with others to engage in the business of dealing in firearms without being licensed dealers. The object of the conspiracy was for Defendants to obtain money from selling firearms.

3. During the course of the conspiracy, Defendants sold at least sixteen (16) firearms, including semi-automatic rifles and shotguns with sawed off barrels, to the CI and others. Defendant GERRAL INGRAM, a/k/a "Rell," served as the primary contact for the CI to arrange for the sale of firearms. The other defendants met with and transported the CI to prearranged secluded locations, stored and retrieved the firearms, or handled the money, all in furtherance of the conspiracy.

OVERT ACTS

3. In furtherance of the conspiracy and to effect its objects, Defendants committed and caused to be committed the following overt acts in the District of New Jersey and elsewhere:

4. On or about July 24, 2009, acting at the direction and supervision of law enforcement, the CI telephoned defendant GERRAL INGRAM, a/k/a "Rell," to arrange for a controlled purchase of a firearm. On or about that same day, defendant INGRAM met the CI at a prearranged secluded location in Newark, New Jersey and handed the CI a Savage 20 gauge pump shotgun with a sawed-off barrel and stock. See Exhibit 1. The CI handed defendant INGRAM approximately \$650.00. This transaction was monitored by law enforcement and consensually video and audio-recorded.

5. On or about August 7, 2009, acting at the

direction and supervision of law enforcement, the CI telephoned defendant GERRAL INGRAM, a/k/a "Rell," to arrange for a controlled purchase of a firearm. On or about that same day, JAHROD KEARNEY, a/k/a "Spazz," acting under the direction of defendant INGRAM, met the CI at a prearranged location in Newark, New Jersey. Defendant KEARNEY directed the CI to a separate secluded location in Newark, retrieved a Siminov 7.62 mm semi-automatic rifle from a hidden location and handed it to the CI. See Exhibit 2. The CI handed defendant KEARNEY approximately \$1,800.00. This transaction was monitored by law enforcement and consensually video and audio-recorded.

6. On or about August 12, 2009, acting at the direction and supervision of law enforcement, the CI telephoned defendant WILLIAM INZAR, a/k/a "Ill Will," to arrange for a controlled purchase of a firearm. On or about that same day, defendant INZAR met the CI at a prearranged secluded location in Newark, New Jersey and handed the CI a Smith & Wesson .38 caliber revolver. See Exhibit 3. The CI handed defendant INZAR approximately \$700.00. This was monitored by law enforcement and consensually video and audio-recorded.

7. On or about August 17, 2009, acting at the direction and supervision of law enforcement, the CI telephoned defendant GERRAL INGRAM, a/k/a "Rell," to arrange for a controlled purchase of a firearm. On or about that same day, defendant INGRAM met the CI at a prearranged secluded location in Newark, New Jersey and handed the CI an Izhevsk 7.62 semi-automatic rifle with an attached bayonet. See Exhibit 4. The CI handed defendant INGRAM approximately \$1,900.00. Defendant INGRAM advised the CI of additional firearms he had for sale. This transaction was monitored by law enforcement and consensually video and audio-recorded.

8. On or about August 25, 2009, acting at the direction and supervision of law enforcement, the CI telephoned defendant GERRAL INGRAM, a/k/a "Rell," to arrange for a controlled purchase of a firearm. On or about that same day, defendants AHMOD BRUTON, a/k/a "Snap," and WADE BRUTON, a/k/a "Bugs," acting at the direction of defendant INGRAM, met the CI at a prearranged secluded location in Newark, New Jersey. Defendant AHMOD BRUTON handed the CI a Norinco 7.62 mm semi-automatic rifle with an attached bayonet. See Exhibit 5. The CI handed defendant AHMOD BRUTON approximately \$1,500.00. This transaction was monitored by law enforcement and consensually video and audio-recorded.

9. On or about September 4, 2009, acting at the direction and supervision of law enforcement, the CI telephoned defendant GERRAL INGRAM, a/k/a "Rell," to arrange for a controlled purchase of a firearm. On or about that same day, defendants INGRAM, WILLIAM INZAR, a/k/a "Ill Will," and WADE BRUTON, a/k/a "Bugs," met the CI at a prearranged location in

Newark, New Jersey. The CI handed defendant INGRAM approximately \$2,000.00. Defendants INGRAM, INZAR and WADE BRUTON then traveled with the CI to meet defendant DANNY JOSEPH at a secluded location in Irvington, New Jersey. At that location, defendant JOSEPH handed a Hi-Point 9 mm semi-automatic rifle to defendant INGRAM who, in turn, handed it to the CI. See Exhibit 6. This transaction was monitored by law enforcement and consensually video and audio-recorded.

10. On or about September 14, 2009, acting in the direction and supervision of law enforcement, the CI telephoned defendant GERRAL INGRAM, a/k/a "Rell," to arrange for a controlled purchase of a firearm. Defendant WADE BRUTON, a/k/a "Buggs" met the CI at a prearranged location in Newark and, at defendant WADE BRUTON's direction, the CI met defendant INGRAM at a separate location in Newark. Defendants INGRAM and WADE BRUTON then brought the CI to a third location to meet an unidentified co-conspirator ("CC-1") at a secluded location in Newark, New Jersey. CC-1 handed defendant INGRAM a Winchester 30-30 caliber lever-action rifle with a sawed off stock and barrel, and defendant INGRAM, in turn, handed it to the CI. See Exhibit 7. The CI handed defendant WADE BRUTON approximately \$1,550.00. This transaction was monitored by law enforcement and consensually video and audio-recorded.

11. On or about September 15, 2009, acting in the direction and supervision of law enforcement, the CI telephoned defendant GERRAL INGRAM, a/k/a "Rell," to arrange for a controlled purchase of a firearm. On or about that same day, defendants WILLIAM INZAR, a/k/a "Ill Will," and WADE BRUTON, a/k/a "Buggs," acting in the direction of INGRAM, met the CI at a prearranged location in Newark, New Jersey. Defendant INZAR retrieved a Smith & Wesson .357 caliber revolver from a hidden location and handed it to the CI. See Exhibit 8. The CI handed defendant INZAR approximately \$800.00. This transaction was monitored by law enforcement and consensually video and audio-recorded.

12. On or about September 18, 2009, acting in the direction and supervision of law enforcement, the CI telephoned defendant GERRAL INGRAM, a/k/a "Rell," to arrange for a controlled purchase of a firearm. On or about that same day, defendants INGRAM, WILLIAM INZAR, a/k/a "Ill Will" and WADE BRUTON, a/k/a "Buggs," met the CI at a prearranged location in Newark, New Jersey. Defendants INGRAM, INZAR and WADE BRUTON then traveled with the CI to meet defendant DANNY JOSEPH at a secluded location in Irvington, New Jersey. At that location, defendant JOSEPH handed defendant INGRAM a Romarm Cugir 7.62 mm semi-automatic rifle, and defendant INGRAM, in turn, handed it to the CI. See Exhibit 9. The CI handed defendant INGRAM approximately \$1,700.00. This transaction was monitored by law enforcement and consensually video and audio-recorded.

13. On or about September 24, 2009, acting at the direction and supervision of law enforcement, the CI telephoned defendant GERRAL INGRAM, a/k/a "Rell," to arrange for a controlled purchase of a firearm. On or about that same day, defendants INGRAM, WILLIAM INZAR, a/k/a "Ill Will," WADE BRUTON, a/k/a "Buggs," and an unidentified co-conspirator ("CC-2") met the CI at a prearranged secluded location in Irvington, New Jersey. CC-2 handed defendant INZAR a KelTec .40 caliber semi-automatic rifle with a collapsible stock and a Winchester 30-30 caliber lever-action rifle, and defendant INZAR, in turn, handed them to the CI. See Exhibits 10 and 11. The CI handed defendant INGRAM approximately \$3,000.00. This transaction was monitored by law enforcement and consensually video and audio-recorded.

14. On or about October 20, 2009, acting at the direction and supervision of law enforcement, the CI telephoned defendant GERRAL INGRAM, a/k/a "Rell," to arrange for a controlled purchase of a firearm. On or about that same day, defendant WADE BRUTON, a/k/a "Buggs," met the CI at a prearranged location in Newark, New Jersey. Defendant WADE BRUTON directed the CI to another secluded location in Newark, New Jersey to meet defendant INGRAM. At that location, defendant INGRAM handed the CI a Hi-Point 9 mm pistol. See Exhibit 12. The CI handed defendant INGRAM approximately \$610.00. This transaction was monitored by law enforcement and consensually video and audio-recorded.

15. On or about October 21, 2009, acting at the direction and supervision of law enforcement, the CI telephoned defendant GERRAL INGRAM, a/k/a "Rell," to arrange for a controlled purchase of a firearm. On or about that same day, defendants INGRAM and WADE BRUTON, a/k/a "Buggs," met the CI at a prearranged secluded location in Newark, New Jersey. Defendant WADE BRUTON retrieved a Romarm Cugir 7.62 mm semi-automatic rifle with an attached bayonet from a hidden location and handed it to the CI. See Exhibit 13. The CI handed defendant INGRAM approximately \$1,800.00. This transaction was monitored by law enforcement and consensually video and audio-recorded.

16. On or about October 27, 2009, acting at the direction and supervision of law enforcement, the CI telephoned defendant GERRAL INGRAM, a/k/a "Rell," to arrange for a controlled purchase of a firearm. On or about that same day, defendants INGRAM, KHAYRI McMILLAN, a/k/a "Kah," and WADE BRUTON, a/k/a "Buggs," and two unidentified co-conspirators ("CC-3" and "CC-4") met the CI at a prearranged secluded location in Newark, New Jersey. Defendant McMILLAN retrieved an FMP Arms .308 caliber semi-automatic rifle from a hidden location and handed it to the CI. See Exhibit 14. The CI handed defendant INGRAM approximately \$1,800.00. This transaction was monitored by law enforcement and consensually video and audio-recorded.

17. On or about November 17, 2009, acting at the direction and supervision of law enforcement, the CI telephoned defendant GERRAL INGRAM, a/k/a "Rell," to arrange for a controlled purchase of a firearm. On or about that same day, defendants INGRAM, KHAYRI McMILLAN, a/k/a "Kah," and WADE BRUTON, a/k/a "Buggs," met the CI at a prearranged secluded location in Newark, New Jersey. Defendant INGRAM retrieved a Romarm Cugir 7.62 mm semi-automatic rifle and a J.L. Galef 20 gauge top-break shotgun with a sawed off barrel from a hidden location and handed them to the CI. See Exhibits 15 and 16. The CI handed defendant INGRAM approximately \$2,600.00. Defendant INGRAM then handed the money over to defendant McMILLAN. Defendant McMILLAN later advised the CI that he had additional firearms for sale. This transaction was monitored by law enforcement and consensually video and audio-recorded.

18. Based on a review of federal firearms registration records, none of the Defendants had federal firearms licenses or were otherwise licensed to deal, import or manufacture firearms at all times relevant.
