The defendant having waived in open Court prosecution by Indictment, the United States Attorney for the District of New Jersey charges:

On or about May 21, 2010, in the District of New Jersey, and elsewhere, defendant

RAMESH ADVANI,

in the special maritime and territorial jurisdiction of the United States, did knowingly engage in and cause sexual contact with another person within the meaning of Title 18, United States Code, Section 2246(3), to wit, the intentional touching, directly and through the clothing, of the genitalia, anus, groin, breast, inner thigh and buttocks of another person, namely G.W., with an intent to abuse, humiliate, harass, degrade, arouse and gratify the sexual desire of any person, while G.W. was incapable of appraising the nature of the conduct and physically incapable of declining participation in or communicating unwillingness to engage in that sexual contact.

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section
2244(a)(2).
