The defendant having waived in open court prosecution by indictment, the United States Attorney for the District of New Jersey charges:

On or about December 2, 2010, in Burlington County, in the District of New Jersey, and elsewhere, the defendant,

DAVID CARPENTER,

did knowingly, by force, violence and intimidation, take from the person and presence of another, namely an employee of Beneficial Savings Bank in Tabernacle, New Jersey, approximately \$10,229.00 in money belonging to and in the care, custody, control, management and possession of the Beneficial Savings Bank in Tabernacle, New Jersey, the deposits of which were then insured by the Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation, and in committing such offense, did assault and put in jeopardy the life of another person by the use of a dangerous weapon, that is, a knife.

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Sections  
2113(a) and 2113(d) and Title 18, United States Code, Section 2.
