
The defendant having waived in open court prosecution by Indictment, the United States Attorney for the District of New Jersey charges:

From on or about September 25, 2007 through on or about July 29, 2008, in the District of New Jersey, and elsewhere, the defendant,

ERIC HAYNBERG,

having knowledge of the actual commission of a felony cognizable by a Court of the United States, that is, wire fraud, contrary to Title 18, United States Code, Section 1343, with respect to weekly time sheets sent by facsimile from New Jersey to New York containing purported hours worked by no-show employee Rocco Mazzaferro at a construction project at 77 Hudson Street, Jersey City, did knowingly and willfully conceal and fail as soon as possible to make known the same to a judge and other person in civil and military authority under the United States.

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 4.
