INFORMATION

The defendant having waived in open court prosecution by indictment, the United States Attorney for the District of New Jersey charges:

1. At all times material to this Information, TD Bank, located at 1450 Clements Bridge Road, Deptford, New Jersey, was a financial institution, as that term is defined in 18 U.S.C § 20, engaged in providing retail and commercial banking services, and therefore, was a business which affected interstate commerce.
2. S.S. was the owner of several Sunoco Gas Stations engaged in providing gasoline and other items for consumers' use. The gas stations received services and supplies from out of state and, therefore, were businesses which affected interstate commerce.
3. On or about June 11, 2010, in Gloucester County, in the District of New Jersey, and elsewhere, defendant

did knowingly and willfully obstruct, delay, and affect commerce and the movement of articles and commodities in commerce by robbery, in that, defendant unlawfully took and obtained money, and aided and abetted the taking and obtaining money, belonging to S.S., the owner of several Sunoco Gas Stations in New Jersey, against his will, by means of actual and threatened

force, violence, and fear of injury, immediate and future, to his person and property, that is, by physical assault by punching him and pushing him against a car while he was in the parking lot of the TD Bank at 1450 Clements Bridge Road, Deptford, New Jersey.

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 1951 and Title 18, United States Code, Section 2.
