The defendant having waived in open court prosecution by indictment, the United States Attorney for the District of New Jersey charges:

From at least on or about August 24, 2010 through on or about October 25, 2010, at Newark Liberty International Airport, in the District of New Jersey, and elsewhere, defendant

ARTURO MARIN

did knowingly and intentionally conspire with Kingsley Roderick Mattis, Johanny Ysles, Christopher Johnson, and others to import into the United States from a place outside thereof, namely, Santo Domingo, Dominican Republic, 500 grams or more of a mixture or substance containing a detectable amount of cocaine, a Schedule II controlled substance, contrary to Title 21, United States Code, Sections 952(a) and 960(b)(2)(B).

In violation of Title 21, United States Code, Section 963.
