I N F O R M A T I O N

The United States Attorney for the District of New Jersey charges:

COUNT ONE
(Adulterated Devices)

From on or about October 7, 2008, until on or about June 8, 2009, in the Township of Wayne, in Passaic County, in the District of New Jersey, and elsewhere, the defendant,

RAM MEDICAL, INC.,

did introduce into interstate commerce and deliver for introduction into interstate commerce medical devices, that is, multiple boxes of surgical hernia mesh, which were adulterated, in that a portion of the devices consisted of a filthy, putrid, and decomposed substance.

In violation of Title 21, United States Code, Section 331(a), Section 333(a)(1), and Section 351(a)(1).

COUNT TWO
(Misbranded Devices)

From on or about October 7, 2008, until on or about January 13, 2010, in the Township of Wayne, in Passaic County, in the District of New Jersey, and elsewhere, the defendant,

RAM MEDICAL, INC.,

did introduce into interstate commerce and deliver for introduction into interstate commerce medical devices, that is, multiple boxes of surgical hernia mesh, which were misbranded, in that the product labeling contained false and misleading information identifying the devices as authentic surgical hernia mesh manufactured by Davol Inc., a subsidiary of C.R. Bard, when in truth the devices were not authentic.

In violation of Title 21, United States Code, Section 331(a), Section 333(a)(1), and Section 352(a).
