The defendant having waived in open court prosecution by indictment, the United States Attorney for the District of New Jersey charges:

From in or about June 2009 through in or about September 2010, in Sussex County, in the District of New Jersey and elsewhere, defendant

THEA SISLER

did knowingly and intentionally convert to her own use the money and property coming into her hands and under her control in the execution of and under the color of her office, employment and service as a Postal Service employee, namely approximately \$69,850 of Postal Service funds, and failed and refused to remit to and deposit in the Treasury of the United States and in a designated depository, and to account for and turn over to the proper officer or agent, the money and property when required to do so by law and the regulations of the Postal Service, and upon demand and order of the Postal Service.

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section

1711.
