INFORMATION

The defendant having waived in open court prosecution by indictment, the United States Attorney for the District of New Jersey charges:

On or about November 4, 2010, in Burlington County, in the District of New Jersey, and elsewhere, the defendant,

DAVID BESAW,

being an inmate at the Federal Correctional Facility at Fort Dix, within the special maritime and territorial jurisdiction of the United States, did unlawfully kill a human being, F.F., without malice and upon a sudden quarrel and in the heat of passion, by pushing F.F. down a flight of stairs recklessly and with extreme disregard for human life, and with the intent to cause F.F. serious bodily injury.

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 1112.
