INFORMATION

The defendant having waived in open court prosecution by indictment, the United States Attorney for the District of New Jersey charges:

COUNT ONE
(Bank Robbery)

On or about July 23, 2010, at Margate City, in the District of New Jersey, and elsewhere, the defendant,

WILLIAM F. PLYLER, III,

did knowingly and willfully by force and violence, and by intimidation, take from the persons and presence of employees of Ocean City Home Bank, located in Margate City, New Jersey, approximately \$2,610.00 in United States currency belonging to and in the care, custody, control, management and possession of that institution, the deposits of which were then insured by the Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation.

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Sections 2113(a) and Title 18, United States Code, Section 2.

COUNT TWO
(Bank Robbery)

On or about August 5, 2010, at Absecon, in the District of New Jersey, and elsewhere, the defendant,

WILLIAM F. PLYLER, III,

did knowingly and willfully by force and violence, and by intimidation, take from the persons and presence of employees of The Bank, located in Absecon, New Jersey, approximately \$4,085.00 in United States currency belonging to and in the care, custody, control, management and possession of that institution, the deposits of which were then insured by the Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation.

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Sections 2113(a) and Title 18, United States Code, Section 2.

At all relevant times to this information, the deposits of Ocean City Home Bank, located in Margate City, New Jersey and the deposits of The Bank, located in Absecon, New Jersey, were insured by the Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation.
