The defendant having waived in open Court prosecution by Indictment, the United States Attorney for the District of New Jersey charges:

COUNT ONE

1. At all times material to this Information, Getty Gas Station was a commercial establishment located at 499-501 Frelinghuysen Avenue in Newark, Essex County, New Jersey, engaged in the sale of gas and other merchandise, an industry which affects interstate commerce.
2. At all times material to this Information, A.S. was an employee of Getty Gas Station.
3. On or about March 8, 2011, in Newark, Essex County, in the District of New Jersey and elsewhere, the defendant,

LAMAR SANDERS,
a/k/a "Tyree Sanders,"

did unlawfully obstruct, delay, and affect, and attempt to obstruct, delay, and affect, commerce as that term is defined in Title 18, United States Code, Section 1951, and the movement of articles and commodities in such commerce, by robbery as that term is defined in Title 18, United States Code, Section 1951, in that the defendants did unlawfully take and obtain personal property consisting of United States currency representing the proceeds of the gas station from the person of and in the

presence of A.S., against A.S.'s will, by means of actual and threatened force, violence, and fear of injury, immediate and future, to A.S.'s person and property in A.S.'s custody, namely by striking A.S. with a firearm and discharging a firearm.

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 1951(a) and Section 2.

COUNT TWO

1. At all times material to this Information, Delta Gas Station, was a commercial establishment located at 872 Clinton Avenue, Newark, Essex County, New Jersey, engaged in the sale of gas and other merchandise, an industry which affects interstate commerce.

2. At all times material to this Information, B.S. was an employee of Delta Gas Station.

3. On or about March 8, 2011, in Newark, Essex County, in the District of New Jersey and elsewhere, the defendant,

LAMAR SANDERS,
a/k/a "Tyree Sanders,"

did unlawfully obstruct, delay, and affect, and attempt to obstruct, delay, and affect, commerce as that term is defined in Title 18, United States Code, Section 1951, and the movement of articles and commodities in such commerce, by robbery as that term is defined in Title 18, United States Code, Section 1951, in that the defendants did unlawfully take and obtain personal property consisting of United States currency representing the proceeds of the gas station from the person of and in the presence of B.S., against B.S.'s will by means of actual and threatened force, violence, and fear of injury, immediate and future, to B.S.'s person and property in B.S.'s custody, namely by striking B.S. with a firearm.

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 1951(a) and Section 2.

COUNT THREE

1. At all times material to this Information, Lukoil Gas Station, was a commercial establishment located at 200 Spring Street, Elizabeth, Union County, New Jersey, engaged in the sale of gas and other merchandise, an industry which affects interstate commerce.

2. At all times material to this Information, O.S. was an employee of Lukoil Gas Station.

3. On or about March 8, 2011, in Elizabeth, Union County, in the District of New Jersey and elsewhere, the defendant,

a/k/a "Tyree Sanders,"**

did unlawfully obstruct, delay, and affect, and attempt to obstruct, delay, and affect, commerce as that term is defined in Title 18, United States Code, Section 1951, and the movement of articles and commodities in such commerce, by robbery as that term is defined in Title 18, United States Code, Section 1951, in that the defendants did unlawfully take and obtain personal property consisting of United States currency representing the proceeds of the gas station from the person of and in the presence of O.S., against O.S.'s will by means of actual and threatened force, violence, and fear of injury, immediate and future, to O.S.'s person and property in O.S.'s custody, namely by striking O.S. with a firearm and discharging a firearm.

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 1951(a) and Section 2.

COUNT FOUR

On or about March 8, 2011, in Union County, in the District of New Jersey, and elsewhere, the defendants,

LAMAR SANDERS,
a/k/a "Tyree Sanders,"

during and in relation to a crime of violence for which he may be prosecuted in a court of the United States, that is, the robbery of O.S. and the Lukoil Gas Station in Elizabeth, Union County, New Jersey in violation of 18 U.S.C. § 1951(a) as charged in Count Three of this Information, did knowingly use and carry a firearm, and possess a firearm in furtherance of such crime, which firearm was discharged, and did aid and abet the same.

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Sections 924(c)(1)(A)(iii) and Section 2.
