The defendant having waived in open court prosecution by Indictment, the United States Attorney for the District of New Jersey charges:

did knowingly possess a computer hard drive, computer disk, and material that contained at least three images of child pornography, as defined in Title 18, United States Code, Section 2256(8), which images were shipped and transported in interstate and foreign commerce by any means, including by computer, and that were produced using materials that were shipped and transported in interstate and foreign commerce by any means, including by computer.

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 2252A(a) (5) (B) and Title 18, United States Code, Section 2.
