The Grand Jury in and for the District of New Jersey,  
sitting at Camden, charges:

1. On or about March 4, 2010, the Federal Bureau of Investigation ("FBI") began a criminal investigation of defendant ROBERT WATERMAN, then a police officer with the Pennsville, New Jersey Police Department, concerning his alleged possession of child pornography.

2. On or about March 4, 2010, special agents with the FBI interviewed defendant WATERMAN and advised defendant WATERMAN of the nature of the investigation.

3. From on or about March 4, 2010 to on or about March 5, 2010, in Salem County, in the District of New Jersey, and elsewhere, defendant


ROBERT WATERMAN

did knowingly alter, destroy, mutilate, conceal and cover up a record and tangible object, namely a Seagate brand hard drive recovered by law enforcement officers on March 5, 2010, with the intent to impede, obstruct, and influence the investigation of a matter within the jurisdiction of a department and agency of the United States, namely the FBI's investigation of defendant

WATERMAN concerning his alleged possession of child pornography.

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section  
1519.
