I, the undersigned complainant, being duly sworn, state that the following is true and correct to the best of my knowledge and belief. From on or about March 2, 2006, to on or about August 16, 2006, in Essex County, in the District of New Jersey and elsewhere, defendants NYRON BRIDGES, a/k/a "Loose Loc," ERIC LONG, a/k/a "EG," JAMAL CLAXTON, a/k/a "Khadafi," DARRYL BISHOP, a/k/a "Womack," LEON JOHNSON, a/k/a "Triple H," ERNEST DAVIS, a/k/a "Ern," and AL-MALIK COLLINS, a/k/a "Push," did:

knowingly and intentionally conspire and agree with each other and others to distribute and possess with intent to distribute a quantity of a mixture or substance containing cocaine base, that is crack cocaine, a Schedule II controlled substance, a quantity of heroin, a Schedule I narcotic drug controlled substance, and a quantity of 3, 4-Methylenedioxymethamphetamine (MDMA), that is, ecstasy, a Schedule I narcotic drug controlled substance, contrary to Title 21, United States Code, Section 841(a) and (b)(1)(C),

in violation of Title 21, United States Code, Section 846.

I further state that I am a Task Force Officer with the Federal Bureau of Investigation, and that this complaint is based on the following facts:

Attachment A

I, Jason Walk, am a Task Force Officer with the Federal Bureau of Investigation. I have knowledge of the following facts based upon my investigation, review of reports and discussions with other law enforcement personnel and others. All statements herein are set forth in substance and in part:

1. Beginning in or about March 2006, an individual cooperating with law enforcement ("CW1") provided information that defendants NYRON BRIDGES, a/k/a "Loose Loc," ERIC LONG, a/k/a "EG," JAMAL CLAXTON, a/k/a "Khadafi," DARRYL BISHOP, a/k/a "Womack," LEON JOHNSON, a/k/a "Triple H," ERNEST DAVIS, a/k/a "Ern," and AL-MALIK COLLINS, a/k/a "Push," belonged to a criminal street gang known as the "Crips."

2. On or about March 2, 2006, CW1 observed members of the Crips including NYRON BRIDGES, a/k/a "Loose Loc," ERIC LONG, a/k/a "EG," JAMAL CLAXTON, a/k/a "Khadafi," DARRYL BISHOP, a/k/a "Womack," LEON JOHNSON, a/k/a "Triple H," ERNEST DAVIS, a/k/a "Ern," and AL-MALIK COLLINS, a/k/a "Push," and others known and unknown, hold a meeting in East Orange, New Jersey. At this meeting, the defendants wore Crips gang "colors," displayed firearms and discussed gang-related criminal activity, including the distribution of crack cocaine, heroin and ecstasy (3, 4-Methylenedioxymethamphetamine (MDMA)).

3. On or about March 9, 2006, in East Orange, New Jersey, CW1 purchased \$800 of "cook up" (which based on my training and experience is slang for cocaine base, or "crack" cocaine) from defendant AL-MALIK COLLINS a/k/a "Push." This transaction was observed by law enforcement and consensually audio-recorded. The "cook up" that CW1 purchased from defendant COLLINS on March 9, 2006, was a white rock-like substance that field-tested positive for the presence of cocaine base and weighed approximately 34 grams (including packaging).

4. On or about March 14, 2006, in East Orange, New Jersey, CW1 purchased four "bricks" (which based on my training and experience is slang for a quantity of heroin) from defendant JAMAL CLAXTON, a/k/a "Khadafi," for approximately \$940.00. This transaction was observed by law enforcement and consensually audio-recorded. The substance contained in the approximately 200 glassine envelopes that the CW purchased from defendant CLAXTON on or about March 14, 2006, field-tested positive for the presence of heroin, and weighed approximately 88 grams (including packaging).

5. On or about May 30, 2006, in East Orange, New Jersey, CW1 purchased \$800 of "cook up" from defendant DARRYL BISHOP a/k/a "Womack." This transaction was observed by law enforcement and consensually audio-recorded. The "cook up" that CW1 purchased from defendant BISHOP on May 30, 2006, was a white rock-like substance that field-tested positive for the presence of cocaine base and weighed approximately 27 grams (including packaging).

6. On or about July 13, 2006, a second individual cooperating with law enforcement ("CW2"), called ERIC LONG a/k/a "EG" to arrange to meet him and purchase "pills" (which based on my training and experience is slang for 3, 4-Methylenedioxymethamphetamine (MDMA), or "ecstasy".) Defendant LONG told CW2 to meet him at location in East Orange, New Jersey. While CW2 was traveling to the pre-arranged location, CW2 spoke with defendant ERIC LONG again on the telephone. At that time, defendant LONG told CW2 that he would not be able to meet him, but that another person would meet CW2 at the pre-arranged location to sell him the "pills." CW2 then arrived at the pre-arranged location in East Orange, New Jersey, where he met ERNEST DAVIS a/k/a "Ern." DAVIS then sold CW2 approximately 10 pills, for \$100. This transaction was observed by law enforcement and consensually video and audio-recorded. The pills field-tested positive for the presence of 3, 4-Methylenedioxymethamphetamine (MDMA).

7. On or about July 26, 2006, in East Orange, New Jersey, CW2 purchased \$540 of "cook up" from defendant ERNEST DAVIS a/k/a "Ern." This transaction was observed by law enforcement and consensually audio-recorded. The "cook up" that CW2 purchased from defendant DAVIS on July 26, 2006, was a white rock-like substance that field-tested positive for the presence of cocaine base and weighed approximately 21 grams (including packaging).

8. On or about August 7, 2006, in East Orange, New Jersey, CW1 purchased \$280 of "cook up" from defendant LEON JOHNSON a/k/a "Triple H." This transaction was observed by law enforcement and consensually audio-recorded. The "cook up" that CW1 purchased from defendant JOHNSON on August 7, 2006, was a white rock-like substance that field-tested positive for the presence of cocaine base and weighed approximately 8 grams (including packaging).

9. On or about August 16, 2006, in East Orange, New Jersey, CW1 purchased \$340 of "cook up" from defendant NYRON BRIDGES a/k/a "Loose Loc." This transaction was observed by law enforcement and consensually audio-recorded. The "cook up" that CW1 purchased from defendant BRIDGES on August 16, 2006, was a white rock-like substance that field-tested positive for the presence of cocaine base and weighed approximately 11 grams (including packaging).
