Woman Sentenced to 8 Years for Involuntary Manslaughter

On March 18, 2010, Roberta Silago, 33, an enrolled member of the Navajo Nation, was sentenced by Senior U.S. District Judge James A. Parker to eight years in federal prison, to be followed by three years of supervised release. Silago pleaded guilty to involuntary manslaughter. The offense occurred near Crownpoint, New Mexico, within the boundaries of the Navajo Nation Indian Reservation.
