Man Charged with Aggravated Sexual Abuse of a Child and Abusive Sexual Contact

Theodore Largo, 38, an enrolled member of the Navajo Nation, appeared in federal court on April 2, 2010, and pleaded not guilty to an indictment charging him with Aggravated Sexual Abuse of a Child and Abusive Sexual Contact. The possible penalty if convicted is a mandatory minimum of 30 years imprisonment. The charges relate to incidents that occurred within the boundaries of the Navajo Nation Indian Reservation. Trial is pending.

The indictment is merely an accusation and the defendant is presumed innocent unless proven guilty.
