INDICTMENT

The Grand Jury charges:

Count 1

On or about May 21, 2010, in McKinley County, in the District of New Mexico, the defendant, **MELVIN PATTON**, unlawfully, knowingly and intentionally distributed marijuana.

In violation of 21 U.S.C. §§ 841(a)(1) and (b)(1)(D).

Count 2

On or about June 14, 2010, in McKinley County, in the District of New Mexico, the defendant, **MELVIN PATTON**, unlawfully, knowingly and intentionally distributed marijuana.

In violation of 21 U.S.C. §§ 841(a)(1) and (b)(1)(D) and 18 U.S.C. § 2.

Count 3

On or about July 30, 2010, in McKinley County, in the District of New Mexico, the defendant, **MELVIN PATTON**, unlawfully, knowingly and intentionally distributed marijuana.

In violation of 21 U.S.C. §§ 841(a)(1) and (b)(1)(D).

Count 4

Between on or about May 21, 2010 and July 30, 2010, in McKinley County, in the District of New Mexico, the defendant, **MELVIN PATTON**, did knowingly open, lease, rent, use, and maintain a place, namely residential premises at # 49 Sunnyside Housing, Crownpoint, New Mexico, for the purpose of distributing and using a controlled substance, to wit: marijuana.

In violation of 21 U.S.C. § 856(a)(1).
