SUPERCEDING INDICTMENT

The Grand Jury charges:

On or about April 4, 2009, in Indian Country, in Santa Fe County, in the District of New Mexico, the defendant, **LINDA DIAZ**, an Indian, did drive a motor vehicle that was involved in an accident that resulted in the death of Philip Espinoza, a non-Indian, and the defendant did knowingly fail to stop and did knowingly fail to render reasonable assistance to Philip Espinoza, including the carrying or the making of arrangements for the carrying of Phillip Espinoza to a physician, surgeon, or hospital for medical or surgical treatment contrary to N.M. Stat. Ann. § 66-7-201(A) and (C).

In violation of 18 U.S.C. §§ 1152 and 13, and N.M. Stat. Ann. § 66-7-201(A) and (C).
