UNITED STATES SUPREME COURT DENIES
TOBY MARTINEZ’S PETITION FOR WRIT OF CERTIORARI

On October 28, 2008, Toby Martinez pleaded guilty to conspiring to defraud the State of New Mexico during the construction of the Bernalillo County Metropolitan Courthouse in Albuquerque. On April 7, 2009, United States District Judge William P. Johnson sentenced Martinez to 67 months’ imprisonment and imposed restitution in the amount of \$2,710,818.66 to the State of New Mexico. Martinez appealed from the sentence. On June 28, 2010, the United States Court of Appeals for the Tenth Circuit affirmed the sentence imposed on Martinez by the United States District Court for the District of New Mexico. Thereafter, Martinez filed a petition for a writ of certiorari with the United States Supreme Court. On November 1, 2010, the United States Supreme Court entered an Order denying Martinez’s petition.
