Minor.INDICTMENT

The Grand Jury charges:

That on or about May 23, 2008, in Indian Country, in Santa Fe County, in the District of New Mexico, the Defendant, **EMERY CALABAZA**, an Indian, did knowingly engage in a sexual act with Jane Doe, who had attained the age of twelve (12) years but not the age of sixteen (16) years, and at the time of the sexual act the Defendant was at least four (4) years older than Jane Doe, and the sexual act consisted of the penetration, however slight, of the genital opening of Jane Doe by the hand or finger of the defendant, who had an intent to abuse, humiliate, harass, degrade, or to arouse or gratify the sexual desire of the defendant.

In violation of 18 U.S.C. §§ 1153, 2243(a) and 2246(2)(C) .
