The United States Attorney charges:

Count 1

Between on or about September 2009 and on or about January 26, 2010, in Taos County *and Luis Cordova*
in the District of New Mexico, the defendant, **JOSE SERGIO ALCAYA-VILLALOBOS** *Pence* did
unlawfully, knowingly and intentionally combine, conspire, confederate, and agree with persons
known and unknown, to commit the following offense against the United States, to wit:
possession with intent to distribute a mixture and substance containing a detectable amount of
cocaine, contrary to 21 U.S.C. §§ 841(a)(1) and (b)(1)(C).


In violation of 21 U.S.C. § 846.

Count 2

Between on or about September 2009 and on or about January 26, 2010, in Taos County,
in the District of New Mexico, the defendant, **JOSE SERGIO ALCAYA-VILLALOBOS**, *and Luis A Cordova*
unlawfully, knowingly and intentionally possessed with intent to distribute a mixture and *Ponce*
substance containing a detectable amount of cocaine.

In violation of 21 U.S.C. §§ 841(a)(1) and (b)(1)(C), and 18 U.S.C. §2.
