**INDICTMENT**

The Grand Jury charges:

**Count 1**

On or about March 11, 2009, in Bernalillo County, in the District of New Mexico, the defendant, **REYNALDO ROMERO-LEON**, having been convicted in the Second Judicial District Court of New Mexico of the following crimes, each being a felony, as each crime was punishable by imprisonment for a term exceeding one year:

D-202-CR-9702312 Trafficking in crack cocaine

D-202-CR-9700026 Trafficking in a controlled substance

D-202-CR-9702652 Trafficking in a controlled substance

D-202-CR-200101499 Trafficking in a controlled substance,

did knowingly possess, in and affecting commerce, a firearm, a Sig Sauer, model P226, nine-millimeter, handgun, serial number U399814, and approximately fifteen cartridges

of nine-millimeter ammunition.

In violation of 18 U.S.C. §§ 922(g)(1) and 924(a)(2).

Count 2

On or about March 11, 2009, in Bernalillo County, in the District of New Mexico, the defendant, **REYNALDO ROMERO-LEON**, who was an alien illegally present in the United States, did knowingly possess, in and affecting commerce, a firearm, a Sig Sauer, model P226, nine-millimeter, handgun, serial number U399814, and approximately fifteen cartridges of nine-millimeter ammunition.

In violation of 18 U.S.C. § 922(g)(5)(A) and 18 U.S.C. § 924(a)(2).
