United States Attorney Richard S. Hartunian announced that DAVID HALL, 27, of Auburn and, more recently, of Syracuse, was sentenced today in federal court pursuant to his previous plea of guilty to a violation of the federal Sex Offender Registration and Notification Act.

In November 2010, HALL, a convicted Level 3 sex offender, pled guilty in federal court to moving from Cayuga County to Virginia in 2008, and then back again, without either notifying New York authorities of his changes of address, nor registering at all in Virginia. Today, Hon. David N. Hurd, United States District Court Judge sentenced HALL to serve 27 months in federal prison as a result of his conviction in this matter. Upon completion of that sentence, HALL will be placed on supervised release for a period of 15 years.

HALL's arrest was the result of an investigation by the United States Marshal's Service and the Cayuga County Sheriff's Office, with assistance from the Syracuse Department, and Onondaga County Sheriff's Office.
