PRESS RELEASE

UNITED STATES ATTORNEY RICHARD S. HARTUNIAN announced that AVIMAEL ROBLERO ROBLERO, age 23, of Troy, New York, pled guilty today before United States District Court Judge Mae A. D'Agostino, in Albany, New York to the felony offense of re-entry by a previously removed alien. Sentencing for ROBLERO ROBLERO is scheduled for August 11, 2011 in Albany, New York. As a result of the conviction, ROBLERO ROBLERO faces a maximum sentence of imprisonment of up to 2 years, supervised release of up to 1 year, and a fine of up to \$250,000.

ROBLERO ROBLERO, a citizen of Mexico, admitted today that he was involuntarily removed from the United States to Mexico on December 4, 2006. On May 12, 2011, ROBLERO ROBLERO was a passenger in a vehicle that was stopped by a Watervliet Police Department officer. Immigration and Customs Enforcement (ICE) officers responded to the vehicle stop and arrested AVIMAEL ROBLERO ROBLERO when they determined that he was a previously removed illegal alien.

This matter was investigated by the Department of Homeland Security, Immigration and Customs Enforcement(ICE), Albany, New York and the Watervliet Police Department.
