PRESS RELEASE

UNITED STATES ATTORNEY ANDREW T. BAXTER announced that AMABLE DE JESUS ESPINAL-LIRIANO, age 41, formerly of Boston, Massachusetts, pled guilty today to illegally reentering the United States after removal, before United States District Court Judge Glenn T. Suddaby, in Albany, New York. Sentencing for AMABLE DE JESUS ESPINAL-LIRIANO is scheduled for April 5, 2010 in Albany, New York. As a result of the conviction ESPINAL-LIRIANO faces a maximum sentence of imprisonment of up to 2 years, supervised release of up to 1 year, a fine of up to \$250,000, and a special assessment of \$100.

ESPINAL-LIRIANO, a citizen of the Dominican Republic, was physically removed from the United States to the Dominican Republic on January 29, 2009 at Miami, Florida. On November 28, 2009, ESPINAL-LIRIANO was encountered and arrested as an illegal alien by United States Border Patrol Agents in Rouses Point, New York.

This matter was investigated by the United States Border Patrol, Champlain, New York.
