## AMMUNITION POSSESSION RESULTS IN INCARCERATION

*Convicted Felon-in-Possession of Ammunition Receives 36 Months Incarceration*

United States Attorney Richard S. Hartunian announced today that **LORENZO BAKER**, age 46, of North Hudson, New York, was sentenced on June 15, 2011 by United States District Court Judge Thomas J. McAvoy to 36 months incarceration and 3 years of supervised release following his release from incarceration. This sentence follows **BAKER'S** plea of guilty to being a Prohibited Person (Felon) in Possession of Ammunition.

**BAKER** previously admitted that on or about September 30, 2009, he possessed approximately 2,300 rounds of assorted ammunition, following previous convictions for felonies.

This prosecution resulted from a joint investigation conducted by the Office of the United States Attorney for the Northern District of New York; Essex County District Attorney's Office; the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms & Explosives; and the New York State Police.
