AMMUNITION POSSESSION RESULTS IN INCARCERATION

Convicted Felon-in-Possession of Ammunition Receives 36 Months Incarceration

United States Attorney Richard S. Hartunian announced today that **LORENZO BAKER**, age 46, of North Hudson, New York, was sentenced on June 15, 2011 by United States District Court Judge Thomas J. McAvoy to 36 months incarceration and 3 years of supervised release following his release from incarceration. This sentence follows **BAKER'S** plea of guilty to being a Prohibited Person (Felon) in Possession of Ammunition.

BAKER previously admitted that on or about September 30, 2009, he possessed approximately 2,300 rounds of assorted ammunition, following previous convictions for felonies.

This prosecution resulted from a joint investigation conducted by the Office of the United States Attorney for the Northern District of New York; Essex County District Attorney's Office; the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms & Explosives; and the New York State Police.
